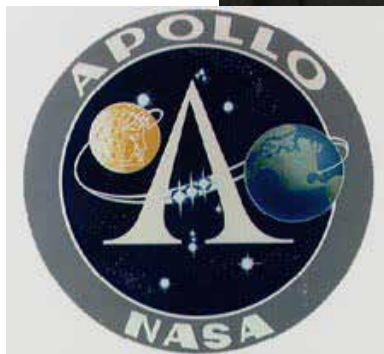
## “Houston, We Have a Problem:

The story of Apollo 13 on its 45th anniversary with Tom Durkin

Forty-five years ago, on April 11, 1970, Apollo 13 lifted off for the Moon. Two days later, with the spacecraft well on its way to the Moon, an oxygen tank exploded, scrubbing the lunar landing and putting the crew in jeopardy. Its “can-do” spirit lives on at NASA.

Tom Durkin is Deputy Director of the NASA South Dakota Space Grant Consortium. Tom provides support and guidance for SDSM&T students funded by the Space Grant, including those who conduct internships at NASA Centers and aerospace industries. Tom also provides various presentations to the general public and school groups about NASA missions and astronomy.
