As a Researcher, Faculty or Staff member involved in Research, please mark your calendar to attend the Export Control Seminar on **April 23<sup>rd</sup>** from 1 pm – 2 pm in McKeel Conference Room (Surbeck Center)

*Export Control regulations are federal laws that prohibit the unlicensed export of certain commodities or information for reasons of national security or protections of trade. An export is any oral, written, electronic or visual disclosure, shipment, transfer or transmission of commodities, technology, information, technical data, assistance or software codes to anyone outside the U.S. including a U.S. citizen, a non-U.S. individual wherever they are (deemed export), or a foreign embassy or affiliate. Methods of disclosure include fax, telephone discussions, e-mail communications, computer data disclosure, face-to-face discussions, training sessions, and tours which involve visual inspections.*

Most research conducted on campus falls within these controls. This seminar will give you all the basic information you need, plus the ability to ask questions directly to the Dept of Commerce representative.
